MaryAnn Faubion Kohl offers a variety of interactive workshops, trainings, seminars, and keynotes. Some of the most frequently asked questions regarding her popular events are found below. In addition, MaryAnn's checklist will give you all the information you need. Ask for your pre-checklist today.

What is the difference between a presentation and a workshop?

An all day event with MaryAnn Kohl is called a full-day *presentation*. Each individual topic presented that day is a *workshop*. A full day presentation, with two workshops, is the most popular and effective framework for what MaryAnn has to offer. A full day presentation typically runs from 8:30am – 3:30pm with two workshops, one before lunch and one after.

Other than full day presentations, what other kinds of events does MaryAnn Kohl offer?

MaryAnn can easily meet the needs of your event. Some choices are: conference keynote, conference breakout sessions, parent night workshop, back to school night, bookstore reading, school visit with children, library gathering, and in-service workshop or training for staff.

What is MaryAnn Kohl's fee?

MaryAnn's one-day presentation fee for a presentation in one location is \$4000 plus expenses (travel and hotel extra), which includes all materials for the hands-on workshops. Though MaryAnn does not collect a deposit at the time of booking, she does charge a cancellation fee of \$500 plus any lost airfare if your group must cancel within 6 months of the event. MaryAnn does *not* require a percentage of registration fees. For a two-day event, add \$3000 for the second day. If MaryAnn must cancel, please inform her of your requirements. Payment is required <u>before or on the day of</u> the presentation. Most groups pay on the same day. Fees and needs of your group are always open to discussion. Always talk over your needs with MaryAnn.

When is payment due?

MaryAnn's speaking fee is due **on or before** the presentation date. Alternative arrangements can be made **in advance** and **in writing**.

What does the all-inclusive fee cover?

Travel expenses, days of travel, pre-planning, prep time, set-up time, all art materials, the actual time spent at the workshop, clean-up ... everything except handouts and table covers. Your group will photocopy handouts and cover the tables. The master handouts will be sent to your group prior to the presentation.

Our group is on a tight budget. Can you suggest options?

A good way to reduce costs is to split the responsibility with another group, such as other preschools or childcare centers, community agencies, or local businesses. You might also consider opening the event up to the community and charging a nominal fee. Please don't hesitate to call MaryAnn for more suggestions. She has seen some creative approaches to saving money, including using air miles donated by the group!

How do I book a date for a MaryAnn Kohl presentation?

MaryAnn's schedule fills about one year in advance. First, email or call MaryAnn at maryann@brightring.com / 800.480.4278 to determine availability. Once a date is selected and an agreement is set, a \$500 cancellation fee will be required (only if your group cancels). In addition, if airfare is lost, that must also be reimbursed. If your group has cancellation requirements, please let MaryAnn know. MaryAnn rarely misses a contracted event, but this did happen once when her husband was ill, so we know it can happen. In this case, MaryAnn will strive to find a suitable replacement for you.

UIs there a minimum or maximum number of attendees?

There is no minimum or maximum number of participants required. Please talk to MaryAnn about how to arrange working with the handson art time for the larger group because the logistics can be more detailed.

What happens after a date is set?

Your date is exclusively reserved, and MaryAnn sends you a detailed checklist, which doubles as a contract.

Can I use a Purchase Order (PO) for MaryAnn's services?

Your group may use a Purchase Order.

Who is responsible for travel arrangements?

MaryAnn will make all of her travel arrangements. Please suggest the best airport and a hotel close to the event.

What types of rooms work best for a MaryAnn Kohl presentation?

The best rooms are conference style or convention rooms (not gymnasiums, which have sound problems). Convention centers, community centers, college student centers, auditoriums, libraries, or community rooms, all with adult sized tables and chairs, work best. Let's talk about what is available and make it work for you. Cameras are welcome but videotaping is not allowed unless prior arrangements are made.

Who is responsible for art materials?

MaryAnn will order and ship all art materials. Your group is responsible for covering the art tables. If attendees can each bring a bottle of glue and a pair of scissors, it would be very helpful but is not required.

Loes MaryAnn Kohl provide references?

Please ask for a list of references and they will be provided from a variety of presentation venues.

Who is responsible for set-up of the workshops?

MaryAnn requires several assistants to help setup the art tables and assist with cleanup. MaryAnn does the majority of set-up.

How can attendees purchase MaryAnn's books?

MaryAnn will order and ship books to the event. She discounts the books 10%-20% for your group, and will work with you to arrange for a volunteer to handle the book sales during the presentation. MaryAnn requires a large table near the entry door in the same room as the presentation for book display and sales. Sales will be in cash and check only, unless your group has credit card services. In addition, MaryAnn's books are available through <u>brightring.com</u>, <u>amazon.com</u>, <u>www.bn.com</u>, <u>ghbooks.com</u> and many catalogs. Books can be ordered at the workshop and sent later, and pre-orders are also a workable alternative.

Does MaryAnn need any special equipment or materials provided at the presentation?

Most full day presentations will typically need the following:

- Sound system; hands-free microphone preferred
 A projector to attach to MaryAnn's laptop, and a screen or blank wall
- A cart for the projector if needed, and a multiplug powercord

• Ten tables for the hands-on art, pre-covered. (MaryAnn does not cover the tables.) Suggested material to cover: inexpensive plastic party table covers or craft paper. Newspaper is an inexpensive alternative. Additional tables needed - to be discussed

- A dolly, cart, or hand truck for unloading materials
- Multiple trash cans
- Access to a kitchen sink for workshop prep and clean up; if no sink is available, tubs of water will be required.
- A table near the microphone for demo supplies
- Knife to open boxes, and tape to seal the boxes after packing up
- Calculator for sales table

MaryAnn provides all other necessary workshop supplies and materials.
